KARATE KATA ADULTS

There are four categories in Karate Kata tournament for adults according to the ranks of contestants. Namely, they are Kakyu, Chukyu, Jokyu amd Black belt categories. Kakyu means the low rank, Chukyu, the middle rank and Jokyu, the high rank. Black belt includes all Dan level.

Contestants must perform 2 Kata in the competition. One Kata is Shitei Kata that is compulsory for all. Another one is Tokui Kata which means one's favorite Kata. Even though Tokui Kata is optional, in this tournament, contestants of Jokyu and Black belt are required to choose their Tokui Kata from Koryu Kata including Kata Sanchin (Jokyu and Black belt) and Kata Tensho (Black belt).

KOBUDO KATA

There are four categories in Kobudo Kata tournament according to the rank of a contestant. Kakyu means the low rank, Chukyu, the middle rank and Jokyu, the high rank. Black belt includes all Dan rank. Contestants must perform 2 Kata for the competition. One Kata is Shitei Kata that is compulsory for all and the other Tokui Kata which means one's favorite Kata. However, for this competition, contestants are not allowed to do any Bo Kata as Tokui Kata. They must do Kata of other weapons such as Tonfa, Sai, Nunchaku, Kama, etc.

KARATE SHIAI KUMITE <u>JUNIORS</u>

Categories

There are eight categories in junior Karate shiai kumite tournament according to the age and the rank of a contestant. Namely, they are Kakyu, Chukyu, Jokyu amd Black belt categories within three age groups. Kakyu means the low rank, Chukyu, the middle rank and Jokyu, the high rank. Black belt includes Shodan and Nidan.

Children under 9 years old are excluded from the tournament. Children between 9 years old and under 14 years old belong to Group A. Students between 14 years old and 16 & ½ years old belong to Group B. They compete with those who are in the same categories of rank.

The rules

- 1. The match lasts for two minutes for junior Kumite tournament.
- 2. Contestants are required to wear the following protectors: 1. Head protector, 2. Body protector, 3. Gloves.
- 3. Contestants are permitted to use only four types of hand striking techniques, i.e. Seiken tsuki, Shuto uchi, Naiwan uchi and Gaiwan uchi. Kicking techniques are strictly prohibited.
- 4. The striking targets are limited only to the front side of the upper left shoulder and the solar plexus. Those striking targets are marked on the body protector.
- 5. When a contestant forcefully hits one of the two targets of his/her opponent with one of the three hand striking techniques in a good posture, he/she is awarded 10 points.
- 5. If a contestant uses his/her opponent with techniques forbidden in the rule, he/she receives Chui and is deducted 10 points from his/her points.
- 6. If a contestant forcefully hits the face or head of his/her opponent, he/she receives Chui and is deducted 10 points from his/her points. If the opponent is injured, the contestant is disqualified.
- 7. A contestant who has gotten more points than the other is the winner.

KARATE KATA <u>JUNIORS</u>

There are twelve categories in Karate Kata tournament for juniors according to the age and the rank of a contestant. Namely, they are Kakyu, Chukyu, Jokyu amd Black belt categories within two age groups. Kakyu means the low rank, Chukyu, the middle rank and Jokyu, the high rank. Black belt includes Shodan and Nidan.

Group A: from 6 years old to 8 years old, Group B: from 9 years old to 13 years old, Group C: 14 years old and above.

There are three types of Kata tournament for juniors: 1. Kata 2. Rhythm Karate Dai Ichi 3. Rhythm Bo Dai Ichi.

1. Kata tournament

Contestants of Group A, Group B and Group C compete with those who are in the same categories of rank. They are required to perform 1 kata that is stated in the list below.

2. Rhythm Karate Dai Ichi tournament

In the tournament of Rhythm Karate Dai Ichi, a pair of contestants makes a team. The pair can be in different grade as long as they belong to the same age group. During the preliminary, the music is not played. The contestants are required to count loud. The music is only played during the semi-final and final. In this tournament 2 teams of contestants perform the Kata together. A team who gets higher points than other wins the match and proceeds to another one. However, if a lost team has obtained more than 24 points, it proceeds to another match as well.

3. Rhythm Bo Dai Ichi tournament

In the tournament of Rhythm Bo Dai Ichi, a pair of contestants makes a team. The pair can be in different grade as long as they belong to the same age group. During the preliminary, the music is not played. The contestants are required to count loud. The music is only played during the semi-final and final. In this tournament 2 teams of contestants perform the Kata together. A team who gets higher points than other wins the match and proceeds to another one. However, if a lost team has obtained more than 24 points, it proceeds to another match as well.

To instructors: Please clarify who will make a pair when you subscribe your students to the tournament. Participants are required to bring their own Bo.

There are four categories in Shiai Kumite tournament of Karate and Kobudo according to the rank of a contestant. Namely, they are Kakyu, Chukyu, Jokyu and Black belt. Kakyu means the low rank, Chukyu, the middle rank and Jokyu, the high rank. Black belt includes all Dan level.

Important:

In Karate Shiai Kumite for adults, a contestant must be 18 years old or above. All contestants must wear full protectors including tennis shoes and a groin protector to minimize the risk of injuries.
